#### **BRING YOUR OWN DEVICE**

Penhold Waskasoo encourages families to take part in our **Bring Your Own Device (BYOD)** program by providing a Chromebook for their child's use at school. While not required, having a personal device supports student learning by giving them consistent access to digital tools and resources used in the classroom. During the summer months, businesses like Staples and BestBuy offer deals on Chromebooks should parents/guardians wish to go with the BYOD route.

#### **SCHOOL AGENDA FEES**

Each student needs to purchase a school agenda, the cost of the agenda is \$9.00 which can be paid online. These fees will be added to your school account.

#### **LOCK FEE**

A combination lock will be supplied to each student for their locker, at the cost of **\$12.00**. This fee will be applied to your quick pay account. Students should not share the combination with any other student. The school will have a master list of combinations in case a student forgets theirs. Locks are also equipped with a keyed entry which is used by administration only. Locks will be used from Grade 4 to Grade 12 at Penhold Crossing Secondary School. Students who use locks that are not provided by the school will have them cut off.
